• A large ecosystem including more than 33 human medecines **Z** production units, 1 pharmaceutical cluster 'Pharmaln' and diverse R&D centers


**Geographical proximity** with **European countries** and **free trade O**agreements with the markets of Sub-saharan Africa, the Middle East and the European Union


A major player in the pharmaceutical industry and the **fourth local producer** with 3 manufacturing sites including one in Cameroun


## GATEWAY TO **AFRICAN MARKET**
